**BRIGHTON BROWNFIELD SITE
PLANNED TO BE REMEDIATED**

Brighton, ON - Mayor Mark Walas, along with municipal staff, met this morning with representatives from Devon Estates, a subsidiary of Imperial Oil Limited, at the site of the former Esso station on the corner of Prince Edward and Elizabeth Streets. At the meeting Imperial Oil advised it plans to effectively remediate the site consistent with protocols established by Ontario's Ministry of the Environment.

Mayor Walas stated "I am thrilled that municipal efforts, including those of the Brighton Economic Development committee, have contributed to Imperial Oil deciding to undertake a remediation project involving soil removal that will allow them to market the property for sale. The remediation of this property is very important to the citizens of Brighton given its highly visible location"

Over the next several months, Imperial Oil will be preparing the site so work (soil removal) can begin in spring 2012. The soil removal project may take several months to complete. Imperial Oil indicated it will continue to communicate with the Municipality of Brighton as the work progresses.
