



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

FIRE CONTROL BY-LAW, By-law No. 043-2009

Residents are reminded that the Municipality of Brighton has a Fire Control By-law (By-law No. 043-2009) in effect. The By-law includes the following:

1. A prohibition on the use of incinerators (burn barrels) in the Brighton urban area (the Brighton urban area is defined as the former Town of Brighton);
2. A prohibition on the setting of brush fires in the Brighton urban area;
3. A prohibition on the burning of "prohibited debris"; defined as any waste, product or thing that, when burned may result in the release to the atmosphere of dense smoke, offensive odors or harmful products, and includes tires, rubber, plastic, pathological waste, household refuse and styrofoam;
4. A requirement that outdoor fireplaces be placed on non-flammable surfaces.
