**RE: Kilbank Lodge Road**

**Recommendation:**

That Council approves the passing of a by-law to change the name of Kilbank Lodge Road to Newton Lane.

**Background/Purpose:**

At the Council meeting on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009, a delegation presented a request from residents on Kilbank Lodge Road to change the name of the road, citing confusion from travelers coming off the 401 looking for lodging, eating establishments or rest facilities. The presentation also referenced incidents of speeding traffic, garbage and waste dumping, etc.

On December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2009, Brighton Council passed a resolution to change the name of Kilbank Lodge Road to Newton Lane.

**Analysis/Comments:**

Notice of the proposed road name change was placed in a local newspaper and on the municipal website fourteen days prior to this meeting. A by-law has been prepared to change the name of this highway. At the time of writing this report we had received no objections or inquiries from the public.

**Financial Implications:**

The financial implications are minimal, consisting of costs for advertising, registration of the by-law and new road signage.
