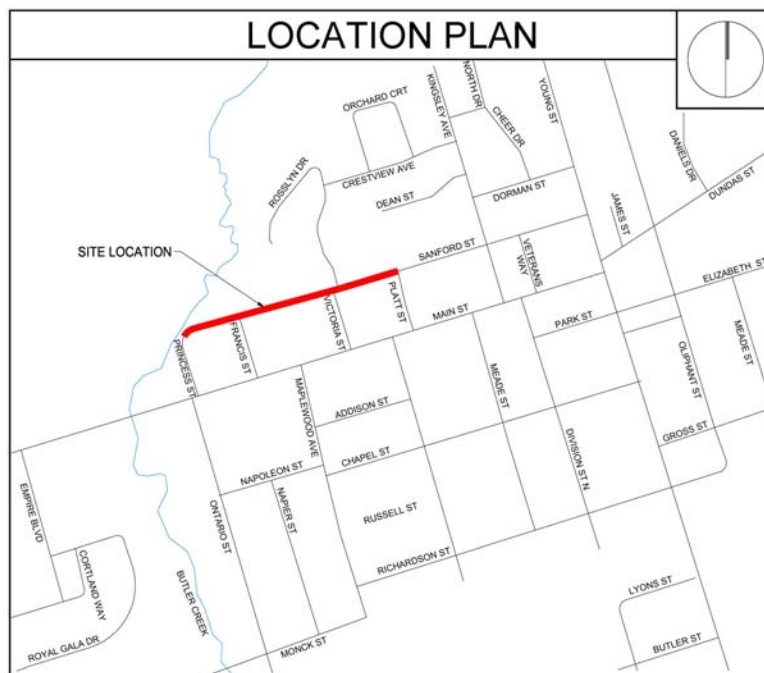




**Notice of Public Information Centre  
Municipality of Brighton  
Reconstruction of Sanford Street**

The Municipality of Brighton is planning to reconstruct Sanford Street from Platt Street to Princess Street, as shown on the plan below. The study area has a semi-urban cross section with numerous drainage issues and poor pavement conditions. The water and storm sewer infrastructure in the study area is nearing the end of its service life and requires replacement in order to provide reliable services to residents. The purpose of this project is to replace the water and storm sewer infrastructure, rehabilitate the sanitary sewer and to reconstruct the road to an urban standard with curb and gutters and sidewalk.



A Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held on Wednesday March 11, 2020 from 3:30 pm to 6:00 pm at the Saint Paul's Anglican Church located at 48 Sanford Street in Brighton. The purpose of this PIC is to provide information about the proposed scope of the project, present plans showing the proposed improvements and to receive input about any local issues within the study area. The PIC will be a drop-in format with displays showing proposed work. Staff from the Municipality and the Consultant team will be on hand to answer any questions. Subject to comments received and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Municipality intends to proceed with the construction of this project in the spring/summer of 2020.
