### QUESTIONS and ANSWERS (in RED)

#### **Question 1:**

Schedule B – Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 notes that a “Bucket truck operator certification (lineman certification)” is required. Can you please specify what is intended by “bucket truck operator certification”, and “lineman certification”. Please confirm that the intent was not experienced bucket truck operator, certified arborist, or an arborist with utility work protection training, line safety and awareness, electrical safety and awareness etc. certifications such as the training offered by the IHSA for working on trees around and within proximity to power lines. I’d like to confirm exactly what specific certifications are required, and who/how many within the crew will require these certifications i.e. Foreman, Bucket Operator, Grounds Person etc.

#### **Response 1:**

1. the deletion of (lineman certification) after Bucket truck operator certification in the first bullet,
2. Fall Arrest reference in fifth bullet should be Working at Heights,
3. all other training and certifications as required, necessary to complete the work.
