**Draft Official Plan Amendment File No. OPA01-2023**  
**Municipal Parks and Recreation Facilities Policies**

**Please Take Notice** that Council will host a Public Meeting on **Monday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023** at **6:30 p.m.** to consider a Draft Official Plan Amendment File No. OPA01-2023 under Sections 17 and 21 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990.

**Take Further Notice** that the Council of the Municipality of Brighton will consider at this meeting amending its Official Plan to revise Section 3.8 policies entitled **Municipal Parks and Recreation Facilities**. The new policies would establish the Municipality's parkland policies and standards as concluded through the Brighton Parks and Recreation Master Plan, provide a framework for the dedication of parkland, and give direction for the development of new parklands within developments.

A copy of the Draft Official Plan Amendment, the related Parks and Recreation Master Plan, and a Draft Parkland Dedication By-law have been prepared for public consultation.
