



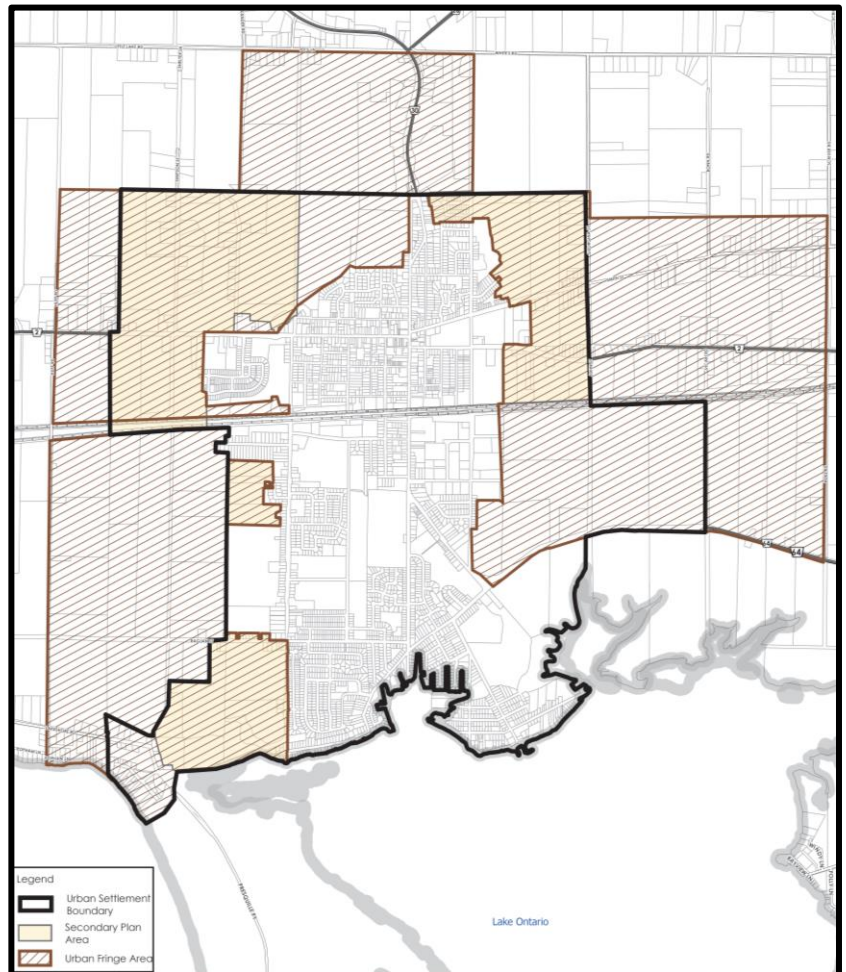
Municipality of Brighton Secondary Plan Project

In accordance with Section 17 of the Planning Act, R.S.O 1990, C.P.13, as amended, the Municipality of Brighton has initiated a Secondary Plan Project to plan for growth and development in the current greenfield lands within the urban settlement boundary of Brighton. Planning proactively for these lands is important to ensure that future development is appropriately designed and reflects the vision for Brighton.

The Secondary Plan Project will develop a refined land use pattern and governing policies for the greenfield areas through the development of a Secondary Plan. See **Figure 1** for the Study Area. The Project will also provide comment on lands adjacent to the urban settlement boundary identified as the urban fringe area.

The Secondary Plan will be informed by and integrated with transportation, stormwater and servicing plans. Also important is the Secondary Plan to uphold community character and public vision. Extensive public consultation will be a key consideration in the development of the Secondary Plan.
