The Corporation of the Municipality of Brighton

By-Law No. 125-2019

Being a By-Law to amend Section 10.0 and Schedule "6" and update By-Law 126-2016, A By-Law to regulate and control vehicular parking on Municipal Property.

Whereas Section 11 (3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25, as amended, provides that a Municipality may pass by-laws with respect to highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

And Whereas Section 428 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a by-law may provide for offences for a vehicle parked in contravention of a by-law passed under this Act;

And Whereas Section 44(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c25, as amended, provides the municipality that has jurisdiction over a highway or bridge shall keep it in a state of repair that is reasonable in the circumstances, including the character and location of the highway or bridge. A municipality that defaults in complying with subsection 44(1) is, subject to the Negligence Act, liable for all damages any person sustains because of the default.

Now, Therefore, the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brighton enacts as follows:

- 1) That Section 10.0 (b) Highway Clearing and Cleaning of the By-Law number 126-2016 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "Between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m., from November 1st to April 1st annually"
- 2) That Schedule "6", Number 24 of the By-Law number 126-2016 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

"Parked between 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. during restricted months"

This By-Law shall come into force and effect upon the date of final passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 18th day of November 2019.
