 The Municipality of Brighton is seeking volunteers who are interested in serving on the Steering Committee for the Official Plan Review. Participation in the review process is important so that the Official Plan reflects the communities' desires for the future of the Municipality.

In the time since the passage of the Municipality's Official Plan, there have been numerous changes in legislation and policy, including amendments to the Planning Act, a new Provincial Policy Statement, and revised Provincial Policy Documents. All of these changes necessitate a comprehensive review and update to the Municipality's Official Plan. The role of the Steering Committee will be to:

- provide comments during the review process;
- assist with issue identification and resolution;
- liaise with key community stakeholders to ensure review awareness; and
- Meet as needed, to monitor the progress of the review.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to serve on the Steering Committee, applicants must:

- be a resident and/or land owner in the Municipality of Brighton;
- be over the age of 18 years;
- demonstrate leadership and advocacy for good planning, and should have a reasonable understanding of land use planning related matters; and,
- not be employed by the Municipality of Brighton

By the deadline of **4:30pm on Thursday, March 14, 2019**, applicants must:
