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Construction Notice

Phase Two of the Harbour Street Reconstruction Project

Commencing the week of August 25, 2025

Please be advised that Phase Two of the Harbour Street Reconstruction project is scheduled to begin the week of August 25, pending the completion of the storm sewer work on Walas Street. This phase of construction will cover Harbour Street from Walas Street to the intersection of Edgewater Drive.

Temporary Water Service

During construction, affected residents and businesses on Harbour Street will be temporarily connected to an alternate water supply. This will involve the placement of temporary water lines across residential lawns and attaching a line to the exterior of each home. A short interruption will occur during the switch over, and advance notice will be provided.

Road Closures and Access

To install the large storm pipes, Harbour Street will be closed from Cedar Street to Mills Road, with a temporary disruption at Edgewater Drive. A detour route to through traffic will be provided. Residents and businesses on Harbour Street will have access to their laneways, although short disruptions may occur when placing concrete, or excavating the new service main. To ensure alternative parking arrangements can be made, notice will be provided in advance when the use of a laneway is not available. Residents who have accessibility requirements or require critical care, are asked to contact municipal staff to arrange accommodations.

Waste Collection

Garbage and recycling collection will continue without interruption. Residents in the construction zone are kindly asked to place bins at the curb by 7:00 a.m. Businesses that have commercial garbage pickup should notify their provider that property access will remain available during construction.

Landscaping

Trees, bushes, and gardens located within in the municipal right-of-way may be trimmed or removed as necessary. The Municipality will attempt to minimize removal or trimming of greenery where possible, however, some trees, bushes, and gardens may need to be removed due to its location over water and sewer lines.

Safety Reminder

This project involves large construction equipment. While safety measures are in place, please ensure that children, pets, etc. are kept at a safe distance from the work area.

Project Background

This project is part of the 2025 Capital Budget and includes the urbanization of these roads with new curbs, storm sewers, sidewalks, asphalt, water services and sanitary sewer repairs. The contractor undertaking this project is Dekeyser Excavating Ltd.
