NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Reconstruction of Walas St. and Harbour St.

Please be advised that construction on Walas Street is set to commence the week of June 2nd, continuing until the Fall of 2025. Work will shift in late July or early August to include Harbour Street from Walas Street to Edgewater Drive.

This work is part of the 2025 Capital Budget and will include the urbanization of these roads with new curbs, storm sewers, sidewalks, asphalt, water service laterals and sanitary sewer cleanouts. New curbs will also be added on Raglan Street transitioning into Walas Drive and a walkway will be installed in the park located between Walas, Raglan and Cedar Streets. The contactor for these works is Dekeyser Excavating Ltd.

Walas Street and sections of Harbour will be closed for the duration of the project with access for local traffic only. Detour routes will be provided for through traffic on Harbour Street. On street parking within the construction zone is prohibited during construction. Some residential driveways will be blocked temporarily to allow for excavation. Those affected will be notified in advance to allow time to make alternative parking arrangements.

Water service to some properties may be impacted for a short time to allow for upgrades to the watermain. 24hr notice will be provided to affected properties in advance of all service interruptions. Water service to affected properties will be restored by the end of each workday. Temporary water services will be installed along Harbour street for the duration of the project.

New storm sewer connections will be provided to homes in the work zone, any sump pumps found to be discharging to the ditches along the front of the property will be connected at no additional cost. Should you know the location of your sump discharge please contact Brock Brunton-Elliott, Development services Tech, to arrange the placement of a marker stake. If your property has a sprinkler system, please do the same so they can be marked to prevent damage.

The Contractor will ensure garbage and recycling pick-up is uninterrupted by construction activity. Affected residents will be notified if there are any additional instructions regarding garbage and recycling pickup.

Driveways and landscaping will be disrupted and where possible the existing storm ditch will be removed. Best efforts will be made to transition yards from the property line to back of curb or sidewalk. Driveways will be saw cut at property line and restored only where disrupted. If a landowner wishes to restore the remaining private side of their driveway, or have additional landscaping completed on private property, it is recommended they contact Dekeyser Excavating Ltd. directly to arrange a quote.

Please be aware that the nature of the work involves large construction equipment. Although safety measures are installed for the project, please ensure that children, pets, etc... are kept a safe distance from all work areas.
