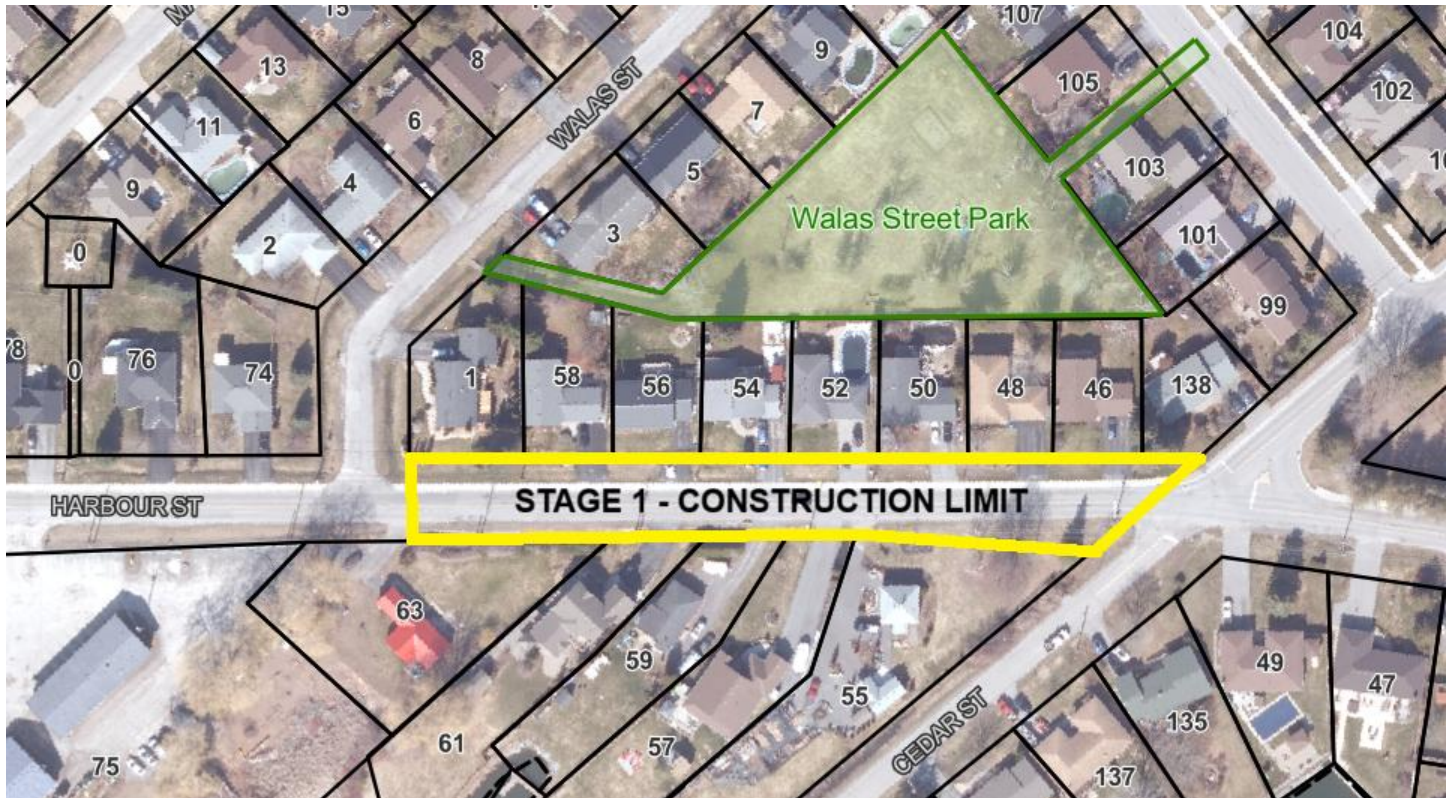


Construction Notice – July 2026 Update

Harbour Street Reconstruction – Stage 1 - Walas Street to Cedar Street



Construction will begin on **Monday, July 6, 2026**, on Harbour Street between **Walas Street and Cedar Street**. This project includes new curbs, storm sewers, multi-purpose pathway, asphalt, water service replacements, and sanitary sewer repairs as part of the Municipality's 2026 Capital Budget.

Road Closures and Access

Harbour Street will be closed to through traffic between Walas Street and Cedar Street for the duration of Stage 1. A signed detour will be provided.

Residents will continue to have driveway access whenever practical. Temporary access interruptions may occur during underground servicing, concrete placement, or other construction activities. Advance notice will be provided whenever possible. Residents requiring accessibility accommodations or critical care should contact Municipal staff.

Water Service Interruptions

Temporary water service interruptions will occur periodically to complete water service replacements within the Stage 1 construction limits. Most interruptions are expected between **8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.** and will typically last **30 minutes or less**.

Residents are encouraged to plan water-related activities, such as showering, laundry, and dishwasher use, outside of this time and keep a supply of drinking water available.

Waste Collection

Garbage and recycling collection will continue as scheduled. Please place materials at the curb by **7:00 a.m.** on your regular collection day.

Commercial properties should advise their waste collection provider that property access will remain available.

Landscaping

Trees, shrubs, gardens, and other landscaping within the municipal road allowance may require trimming or removal. Every effort will be made to minimize impacts; however, vegetation over underground infrastructure may need to be removed to complete the work safely.

Construction Safety

Please use caution around the construction zone and keep children and pets away from work areas and equipment.
