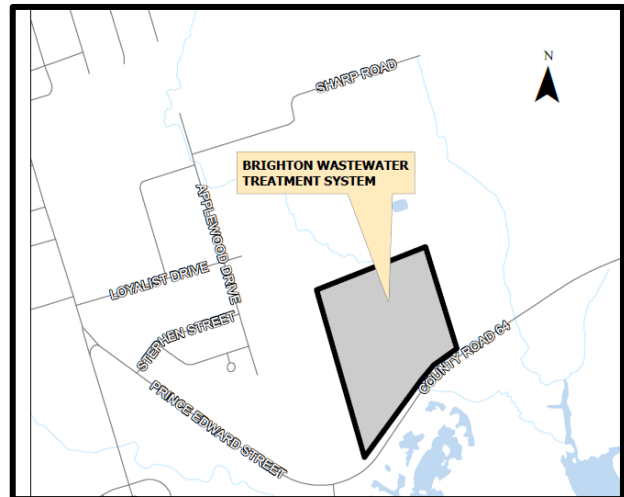
Municipality of Brighton Brighton Wastewater Treatment System Expansion Schedule C Class EA

The Municipality of Brighton has initiated a Schedule C Class Environmental Assessment for the most suitable solution for wastewater treatment expansion in Brighton.

How Will This Affect Me?

The Municipality is looking to expand the Wastewater Treatment System (WWTS) to increase treatment capacity and enable future growth in the community. The Class EA will capture the proposed design and alternatives considered for the Brighton WWTS, including updated growth projections, design basis and treatment options.

Public and agency consultation is a key element of the process. Based on your input, alternative strategies will be evaluated to identify optimal community, environmental and economic opportunities.



How Do I Get More Information?

Two (2) Public Information Centre(s) (PIC) will be conducted, and notice of these sessions will be provided at least two (2) weeks in advance. In the meantime, the study team is reviewing background data and determining alternative solutions.
